

## Morrison School of Agribusiness Departmental Scholarships

Scholarship applications for the 2017-2018 academic year are available. **The deadline for first-time freshman is January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017.** The deadline for transfer students and current ASU students is January 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

To apply for scholarships, complete the W. P. Carey School of Business general scholarship application form at <https://wpcarey.asu.edu/scholarships>. The W. P. Carey School of Business uses a single application for all scholarships. Students are then matched to appropriate Morrison School of Agribusiness scholarships within the W. P. Carey School. **Note that students must first apply to ASU in order to fill out the scholarship application.**

As part of the application, students will be required to provide a resume and a few essays regarding their leadership experiences and their educational and career goals. It is important that students emphasize the following in their resume and essays:

**FFA Experience** – Many of the scholarships offered by the Morrison School of Agribusiness have the criteria of FFA experience, especially leadership experience (the Kenneth and Judith Williams Family Scholarship; the George Seperich Scholarship; and several others).

**Other Criteria** - There are also a few scholarships with very specific criteria. Students matching any of the following criteria should emphasize in their essays and resume:

- Graduate of a high school in the Santan Region
- Graduate of Queen Creek High School
- Graduate of a West Valley high school
- Expressed interest in production agriculture (specifically being a farmer)
- Expressed interest in livestock marketing
- Expressed interest in produce commodities or specialty crops
- Students interested in food retailing (e.g., grocery; supplier organizations like Coca-Cola; consumer packaged goods) or who currently work for an Arizona food retail or supplier organization (criteria for the Arizona Food Marketing Alliance Scholarship).
